

At the moment when Ningxia wolfberry is about to move towards high-quality development, the Chinese version of the book is published to scientifically understand the health value of authentic wolfberry and help the domestic wolfberry industry to connect with the world.

American Herbal Pharmacopoeia (AHP), abbreviated as AHP, is a brand owned by a non-profit organization of the same name in the United States. The organization is committed to promoting the correct use of plant products and herbs, and is supported by a global network of experts, covering various professional fields such as botany, chemistry, herbalism, medicine, pharmacy, and pharmacology. The main work of AHP includes compiling herbal medicine monographs, providing plant material reference materials and plant identification services. Special collection of medicinal plants available for market circulation is the most important basis for the management and use of herbal products in the United States, and has a recognized authority in the international community.



In August 2018, Professor Michael Heinrich, an expert on the final review of AHP "Goji Berry", the School of Pharmacy, University of London, visited Zhongning.

AHP began to compile herbal medicines in 1994, and plans to publish 300 copies, which will basically cover the exotic botanicals commonly used in the United States, and finally form a classic and authoritative

English herbal literature system. According to its plan, the content of the pharmacopoeia includes taxonomic nomenclature, history, identification, product source and processing, chemical composition, analysis and determination, curative effect, safety, international status, Chinese pharmacy information, etc., which will be used by scholars, healthcare providers, production Businesses and managers provide important references.



In August 2018, Professor Michael Heinrich, an expert on the final review of AHP "Goji Berry", the School of Pharmacy, University of London, visited Zhongning.

As of March 2019, AHP has published 38 herbal medicines. In view of the increasing value of Chinese authentic wolfberry in Western medical and health care, the "Goji berry" sub-volume was officially released on March 20, 2019.

The book "Lycium barbarum" systematically organizes and scientifically discusses ten aspects including taxonomic nomenclature,

history, identification, commercial sources and processing, chemical composition, analysis and determination, efficacy, safety, international status, and supplementary information on traditional Chinese medicine. The book records the culture, medicinal history and modern development of wolfberry in China for more than 4,000 years, and organizes "Supplementary Information on Traditional Chinese Medicine" in a special chapter. The book will provide systematic knowledge about goji berries in academic fields, scientific research fields, large health industry fields and the general public, and help people understand the health value of goji berries more scientifically.

Wang Zigui, a senior member of the Chinese Society for Food Science and Technology, and Yao Ruyu, a postdoctoral fellow at the Institute of Medicinal Botany, Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences and Peking Union Medical College, participated in the editing and review of the book as Chinese experts, and then led the team. It took 1 year to complete the AHP "Goji Berries" "The translation work was officially published and distributed by the Sunshine Publishing House of the Yellow River Publishing and Media Group.
